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EXPLANATORY NOTES

The object of this bill is to amend the Act respecting the Ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux to require the Minister to establish policies that encourage organ donation, in collaboration with the organization responsible in Québec for coordinating human organ and tissue removal and transplantation.

Under the bill, the Minister is required to adopt or see to the adoption of regulations allowing an indication of consent to organ or tissue removal for transplantation purposes to be placed on a person's health-insurance card or driver's licence.

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THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Act respecting the Ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux (R.S.Q., chapter M-19.2) is amended by inserting, after section 3, the following section:

“3.1 The Minister, in collaboration with the organization responsible in Québec for coordinating the removal and transplant of human organs and tissue, shall devise policies to encourage organ donation.

To that end, the Minister shall, in particular, adopt or see to the adoption of regulations allowing an indication to be placed on a person’s health-insurance card or driver’s licence establishing that the person has consented to organ or tissue removal for transplantation purposes.”
