Bill 397

An Act to amend the Act respecting income support, employment assistance and social solidarity

Introduction

Introduced by Mr Mario Dumont Member for Rivière-du-Loup

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill amends the Act respecting income support, employment assistance and social solidarity in order to extend to every person, regardless of age, the obligation to attend an interview at the Minister's request in order to enable the Minister to evaluate the person's circumstances and determine certain activities to be engaged in as part of an Individualized Integration, Training and Employment Plan.

Bill 397

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ACT RESPECTING INCOME SUPPORT, EMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE AND SOCIAL SOLIDARITY

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- **1.** Section 56 of the Act respecting income support, employment assistance and social solidarity (1998, chapter 36) is amended by replacing the first paragraph by the following:
- "**56.** An independent adult or an adult who is a member of a family without dependent children must, if the adult's capacity for employment is not limited within the meaning of section 24 or 25, attend an interview at the Minister's request to enable the Minister to evaluate the adult's circumstances and determine certain activities to be engaged in as part of an Individualized Integration, Training and Employment Plan."
- **2.** This Act comes into force on the date fixed by the Government, but not prior to 1 September 2000.
