



EXTRAIT DE PÉTITION

(Article 64 du Règlement)

Je dépose l'extrait d'une pétition adressée à l'Assemblée nationale, signée par 3 758 pétitionnaires.

Désignation : Citoyens et citoyennes du Québec

Les faits invoqués sont les suivants :

GIVEN THAT there is unequal opportunity for all Quebecers when it comes time to choose the best public education for their children;

GIVEN THAT English School Boards provide a high caliber of French immersion instruction;

GIVEN THAT Bill 103 does not resolve the issue of buying education in an English school in Quebec;

GIVEN THAT the future of the English community and the French language needs to be protected and that the elected officials (MNA's & Cabinet Ministers) voted by the general public have the mandate to protect the rights of all citizens of Quebec regardless of linguistic, ethnic or socio-economic status;

Et l'intervention réclamée se résume ainsi :

We, the undersigned, ask the government of Quebec to revise Bill 103 and to include provisions to allow increased access to public English schools.
