Bill 197

An Act to amend the Auditor General Act in order to allow comprehensive auditing of Hydro-Québec

Introduction

Introduced by Mr. Sylvain Gaudreault Member for Jonquière

EXPLANATORY NOTES

The purpose of this bill is to allow the Auditor General to audit the adequacy and functioning of systems and procedures implemented by Hydro-Québec to ensure that its resources are acquired and utilized with due regard to economy, efficiency and effectiveness.

To this end, the bill amends the Auditor General Act and specifies that the Auditor General need not secure the concurrence of the board of directors of Hydro-Québec before conducting an audit.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE AUDITOR GENERAL ACT IN ORDER TO ALLOW COMPREHENSIVE AUDITING OF HYDRO-QUÉBEC

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 28 of the Auditor General Act (R.S.Q., chapter V-5.01) is amended by inserting the following paragraph after the second paragraph:

"Such concurrence is not required in the case of Hydro-Québec."
