To the Minister for Social Services:

Since 2006, the Regroupement des organismes Espace du Québec (ROEQ) has been trying to obtain financing for its Consolidation and Development Plan.

The importance of taking action to prevent violence against children has attracted a broad consensus of support in Québec and the contribution made by the Espace agencies of Québec (ROEQ) in this regard has often been recognized. The Espace programme has already been assessed by a reputable and independent researcher of the ROEQ. It has received several awards, the latest being the Prix Droits et Libertés 2009 awarded by the Commission des droits de la personne et des droits de la jeunesse.

On 22 December 2010, the Ministère de la Santé et des Services sociaux (MSSS) sent a letter to the ROEQ whereby it acknowledges that the Espace programme indeed remains a good choice for schools, but also indicates that "increasing the operating budget of the ROEQ is not possible" for 2010-2011.

On 15 February 2011, the ROEQ sent a letter to the MSSS again asking that it provide financing for this plan in the new fiscal year. To this day, the ROEQ has not received an answer.

Considering that the examination of requests to the Support to Community Agencies Programme has just begun, does the Minister intend to finance the ROEQ's Consolidation and Development Plan in 2011-2012?
