THAT the National Assembly:

- I** Concur in the position and justifications given by the Government and stipulated in its answer to the report from the committee on the remuneration of judges for the period of 2010-2013, tabled before the Assembly on 17 February 2011;
- II** Approve recommendations 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 15, 17, 18, 19, 20, 22, 23 and 24, and specify:
 - as regards recommendations 8, 18 and 24, the partial reimbursement of disbursements for experts and representational expenses incurred by the conferences of judges is granted without admissions regarding the power of the committee to make recommendations and regarding the evaluation of percentages established by the Comité for reimbursement purposes;
 - recommendation 6 is approved except for the text of the amendments to sections 92 and 116 of the *Courts of Justice Act* proposed by the committee;

- III** Amend recommendations 1, 9 and 14 relating to the salary of the judges of the Court of Québec, the municipal court judges of Laval, Montréal and Québec, and the municipal court judges paid per sitting, by removing, for the years 2011-2012 and 2012-2013, the portion of the salary increase corresponding to compensation for the increase in insurance premiums, in such manner that the salary of these judges be established as follows:

Recommendation 1 (judges of the Court of Québec)

- as at 1 July 2010: \$225,737 (salary as at 30 June 2010 increased by 2.02 %);
- as at 1 July 2011: \$227,488 (increase of 0.78 %);
- as at 1 July 2012: \$230,723 (increase of 1.42 %);

Recommendation 9 (judges of the municipal courts of Laval, Montréal and Québec)

- as at 1 July 2010: \$192,464 (salary as at 30 June 2010 increased by 0.5 %);
- as at 1 July 2011: \$193,861 (increase of 0.73 %);
- as at 1 July 2012: \$196,425 (increase of 1.32 %);

Recommendation 14 (municipal judges paid per sitting)

- as at 1 July 2010: \$192,464 (maximum salary as at 30 June 2010 increased by 0.5 %);
