To the Minister of Municipal Affairs, Regions and Land Occupancy:

Within the framework of regional and rural development (Pacte rural), financial aid equivalent to the percentage of the maximum eligible costs granted for various projects is of 60 % but may be increased by 20 % in devitalized municipalities. However, as regards financing of municipal infrastructures (Programme d'infrastructures Québec-Municipalités [PIQM]), particularly water supply and drinking water treatment infrastructures, the percentage of the maximum eligible cost of work of 50% cannot be increased to take into account

the devitalization of municipalities. Within this context, why does the Ministère des Affaires municipales, des Régions et de l'Occupation du territoire (MAMROT) not take into account the devitalization of municipalities in order to index the financing of the PIQM as it does with the Pacte rural programme? Furthermore, what criteria does the MAMROT use to assess a municipality's need for additional financing? Would it be possible to know what worksheet is used by the public servants?
