(10) Mr. Gaudreault (Jonquière) – **2 November 2011**To the Minister of Natural Resources and Wildlife:

For the past several months, I have been working at developing a portrait of the situation with regard to the use of public domain hydraulic powers by the AbitibiBowater company in the Saguenay–Lac-Saint-Jean region. In March 2011, through a request made in pursuance of the *Act respecting Access to documents held by public bodies and the Protection of personal information*, I obtained from the Ministère des Ressources naturelles et de la Faune (MRNF) a series of leases and contracts. The Ministère indicated at that time that it did not have in its possession the documents concerning the Chicoutimi power plant on the Chicoutimi River and the Bésy and Jonquière power plants on the Aux Sables River.

Last 17 October, the Radio-Canada radio station in the Saguenay region broadcast news to the effect that hydraulic power was leased to AbitibiBowater for only four of the eight power plants that it operates in the region. Philippe Desjardins of the MNRF stated that in the early 1900's, the Québec Government, to promote economic development, sold, under full ownership, certain hydraulic powers and the lands required to operate them to some companies.

I would like to receive explanations and documents (contracts or other agreements) indicating to whom belong the hydraulic powers used to operate the Murdock-Wilson power plant on the Shipshaw River, the Jonquière and Bésy power plants on the Aux Sables River, as well as the Chicoutimi power plant on the Chicoutimi River, and how the operation of these hydraulic powers is governed.

(11) Mr. Bergeron (Verchères) – **15 November 2011**To the Minister for Transport:

Last 27 October, a question was addressed to the Minister for Transport regarding the situation of the Chemin des Patriotes alongside the Richelieu River in Saint-Denis-sur-le-Richelieu and which was the scene, last 20 October, of an unfortunate landslide. There are concerns that this landslide may have been caused by heavy traffic circulating on this road and which may cause vibrations affecting the bearing capacity of the clay soil on which Route 133 is built.

However, at a press conference held last 28 October by the territorial branch of the Ministère, Mr. Denis Demers, engineer at the Service géotechnique et géologie of the Ministère des Transports du Québec, stated that the collapse of this portion of Route 133 occurred because of the phenomenon of shoreline erosion.

In an effort to reassure the riverside residents of the Chemin des Patriotes, can the Minister for Transport address this issue and tell us what the Government intends to do to prevent other sections of Route 133 from collapsing owing to the effect of shoreline erosion?

The Ministère des Transports had performed repairs on the section of Route 133 just before it collapsed. It was therefore aware of the erosion problem and of the increased danger of the curve located in this area.

Why have waited until the situation deteriorated to this point before undertaking not only surface work, but also major stabilization work that would have prevented such an incident, thankfully without consequence, from happening?

Following this incident, the Ministère des Transports stated that it would introduce mitigation measures for the residents of Saint-Denis-sur-le-Richelieu who were directly affected by this collapse and for users who, both upstream and downstream, must use this temporarily closed section daily.

For the benefit of the affected citizens, can the Minister tell us what type of mitigation measures he intends to set up and what he intends to do to reduce the substantial detour that motorists must now make?
