AN ACT RESPECTING THE FRENCH-WORLD THEOLOGICAL INSTITUTE (FTI)

AS the French-World Theological Institute (FTI) was created by letters patent on 12 July 2005 under the Canada Corporations Act (Revised Statutes of Canada, 1970, chapter C-32) under the English name French-World Theological Institute (FTI) and the French name Institut de théologie pour la francophonie (ITF);

AS the Institute provides recognized instruction for the training of pastors and ministers of religion of several Protestant denominations in Québec and throughout the francophone world;

AS the Institute fulfills a unique mission in the field of higher education in Québec and in the Francophonie in the Protestant tradition;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- **1.** The French-World Theological Institute (FTI) may, in the ecclesiastical sciences, with the authorization of the Minister of Education, Recreation and Sports and on the conditions the Minister determines, offer university-level programs and grant degrees, diplomas, certificates and other attestations of university studies.
- **2.** This Act comes into force on (insert the date of assent to this Act).
