## **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

*The purpose of this bill is to repeal certain provisions of the Act to enable students to receive instruction from the postsecondary institutions they attend, including certain provisions of Division II, entitled “Continuity of Instructional Services”, Division III, entitled “Provisions to Maintain Peace, Order and Public Security”, Division IV, entitled “Administrative and Civil Measures”, and Division V, entitled “Penal Provisions”.*

## **LEGISLATION AMENDED BY THIS BILL:**

– Act to enable students to receive instruction from the postsecondary institutions they attend (2012, chapter 12).

## **Bill 597**

### **AN ACT TO AMEND THE ACT TO ENABLE STUDENTS TO RECEIVE INSTRUCTION FROM THE POSTSECONDARY INSTITUTIONS THEY ATTEND**

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1.** Sections 9 and 13 to 31 and the second paragraph of section 32 of the Act to enable students to receive instruction from the postsecondary institutions they attend (2012, chapter 12) are repealed.
- 2.** Section 35 of the Act is replaced by the following section:

**“35.** The Minister of Education, Recreation and Sports is responsible for the administration of this Act.”
- 3.** This Act comes into force on (*insert the date of assent to this Act*).
