The Assembly proceeded to Oral Question Period.

Motions Without Notice

Mrs. Roy (Montarville) moved a motion concerning the reimbursement of the school tax increase by the school boards; this motion could not be debated for want of unanimous consent.

By leave of the Assembly to set aside Standing Order 185, Mr. Hébert, Minister of Health and Social Services, together with Mr. Bolduc (Jean-Talon), Mrs. Daneault (Groulx), Mr. Khadir (Mercier) and Mr. Ratthé (Blainville), moved:

THAT the National Assembly underline the 2013 Québec health and social services network Users' Rights Week;

THAT it thus pay tribute to the men and women who actively take part in the decisions affecting their health and wellbeing by getting involved in the user committees of our health care facilities;

THAT it also take this opportunity to commend their commitment that benefits the ongoing improvement of our health network;

Lastly, that it recognize that their contribution serves all of Québec's population.

By leave of the Assembly, the motion was carried.

By leave of the Assembly to set aside Standing Order 185, Mrs. David (Gouin), together with Mr. Blanchet, Minister of Sustainable Development, Environment, Wildlife and Parks, Mr. Sklavounos (Laurier-Dorion), Mr. Martel (Nicolet-Bécancour) and Mr. Ratthé (Blainville), moved:

THAT the National Assembly acknowledge the seriousness of the findings of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC);

THAT the National Assembly urge the Government to convene the standing Committee on Transportation and the Environment without delay to hold consultations on Québec's greenhouse gas reduction target, in pursuance of section 46.4 of the *Environment Quality Act*.

By leave of the Assembly, the motion was carried.

Mr. Traversy, Deputy Government House Leader, convened the following Committee:

— the Committee on Public Administration shall hold a deliberative meeting to prepare the hearing on the control and monitoring of municipal wastewater treatment and of the production of drinking water; it shall then hold a public meeting to hear the Ministère du Développement durable, de l'Environnement et des Parcs, and the Ministère des Affaires municipales, des Régions et de l'Occupation du territoire; and, finally, it shall hold a deliberative meeting to discuss the observations, conclusions and recommendations, if any, following these hearings.

Business Standing in the Name of Members in Opposition

Mr. Deltell (Chauveau) moved:

THAT the National Assembly ask the Government to introduce a bill to extend the limitation period provided for in the *Election Act* and to enable the Québec Chief Electoral Officer to institute proceedings for offences committed during the entire period covered by the Charbonneau Commission;

THAT the National Assembly ask the political parties to formally commit to reimbursing all amounts illegally received during this same period.

Following a meeting held with the House leaders, Mr. Cousineau, Second Vice-President, informed the Assembly of the allocation of speaking time for the proceedings with respect to this motion: 10 minutes shall be allotted to the mover of the motion for his reply; approximately 40 minutes shall be allotted to the parliamentary group forming the Government; approximately 27 minutes shall be allotted to the parliamentary group forming the Official Opposition; approximately 37 minutes shall be allotted to the Second Opposition Group; and 6 minutes shall be allotted to the independent Members. Within this framework, any time not used by the independent Members or by any of the parliamentary groups shall be redistributed among the parliamentary groups in proportion to their representation in the Assembly. Lastly, individual addresses shall not be limited.

The debate arose thereon.

The debate being concluded, the question was put on this motion; a recorded division was thereupon demanded.
