EXPLANATORY NOTES

The purpose of this bill is to replace the electoral division name “Brome-Missisquoi” as assigned in the list of electoral divisions published in the Gazette officielle du Québec by “Brome-Missisquoi–Shefford”.

AN ACT TO REPLACE THE NAME OF THE ELECTORAL DIVISION OF BROME-MISSISQUOI BY BROME-MISSISQUOI–SHEFFORD

AS, according to the electoral map that was drawn up in accordance with the list of electoral divisions dated 12 October 2011 and that came into force on 4 September 2012, the electoral division of Brome-Missisquoi comprises 25 municipalities, including 3 that were formerly part of the electoral division of Shefford;

AS the name “Brome-Missisquoi–Shefford” better reflects the whole of the territory actually covered by the electoral division;

AS it is appropriate to foster a sense of belonging in all citizens in the electoral division;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The list of electoral divisions established on 12 October 2011 by the Commission de la représentation under section 29 of the Election Act (chapter E-3.3) and published in the *Gazette officielle du Québec* dated 20 October 2011 (2011, G.O. 2, 2969A) is amended by replacing the electoral division name “Brome-Missisquoi”, wherever it appears, by “Brome-Missisquoi–Shefford”.
