EXPLANATORY NOTES

The object of this bill is to amend the Act respecting childcare centres and childcare services to allow a non-profit legal person or cooperative wishing to obtain a childcare centre permit to be exempted from the requirement to coordinate, monitor and supervise the educational childcare provided by home childcare providers if it shows that the centre is located in an industrial area or set up on the premises of a workplace.

The bill also provides that holders of a childcare centre permit whose facility is located in an industrial area or a workplace may choose not to coordinate, monitor and supervise educational home childcare provided they so inform the Minister.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ACT RESPECTING CHILDCARE CENTRES AND CHILDCARE SERVICES

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS :

1. Section 1 of the Act respecting childcare centres and childcare services (R.S.Q., chapter C-8.2) is amended by inserting “, subject to the third paragraph of section 7.1,” after “and that” in the fourth line of the definition of “childcare centre”.
2. Section 7.1 of the said Act is amended by adding the following paragraph at the end :

“However, a person applying for a childcare centre permit whose facility is located in an industrial area or a workplace is not required to undertake to coordinate, monitor and supervise educational home childcare.”
3. Section 9 of the said Act is amended by inserting “, where applicable,” after “shall” in the first line.
4. Section 11.0.1 of the said Act is amended by inserting “, where that is the case,” after “recognized” in subparagraph 5 of the first paragraph.
5. Section 11.1.1 of the said Act is amended by replacing “the recognized home childcare providers” in the third paragraph by “any home childcare providers recognized by the permit holder”.
6. The holder of a childcare centre permit whose facility is located in an industrial area or a workplace and does not coordinate, monitor or supervise educational home childcare is not required to do so provided the Minister is informed of the choice that has been made.
