AN ACT RESPECTING VILLAGE DE KINGSBURY

AS it is in the interest of Village de Kingsbury and necessary for its proper administration that it be granted certain powers relating to its industrial development;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1.** Despite the second paragraph of section 7 of the Act respecting municipal industrial immovables (R.S.Q., chapter I-0.1), Village de Kingsbury may lease, for a term exceeding six years, all or part of the immovable it acquired under a deed of sale registered at the registry office of the registration division of Richmond on 17 July 1992 under No. 190723.
- 2.** The leases granted by Village de Kingsbury since 14 July 1992 on the immovable referred to in section 1 are declared valid.
- 3.** This Act comes into force on (*insert the date of assent to this Act*).
