AN ACT RESPECTING MUNICIPALITÉ RÉGIONALE DE COMTÉ DE TÉMISCOUATA

AS it is in the interest of Municipalité régionale de comté de Témiscouata that certain powers be granted to it;

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1.** Municipalité régionale de comté de Témiscouata may constitute a limited partnership with a private-sector enterprise or Hydro-Québec for the purpose of producing electricity from wind power.
- 2.** The private-sector enterprise or Hydro-Québec must, at all times, have furnished at least half of the contribution to the common stock of the partnership, and must be the partnership's general partner.
- 3.** No local municipality whose territory forms part of that of the regional county municipality may exercise a right of withdrawal in relation to the exercise of the power of the regional county municipality under section 1.
- 4.** With the authorization of the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Regions, the regional county municipality may become surety for the partnership referred to in section 1.

Before giving authorization, the Minister may order the regional county municipality to submit the resolution or by-law authorizing the suretyship to the persons qualified to vote in all the local municipalities or in one or more of them, for approval.

- 5.** For the purposes of this Act, the regional county municipality may acquire any immovable by agreement or expropriation with a view to transferring or leasing it to the partnership referred to in section 1.
- 6.** This Act comes into force on *(insert the date of assent to this Act)*.
